



ED5152: PRACTICUM: FACILITATING AN ONLINE WORKSHOP

Course Description

This practicum provides participants with the opportunity to apply the facilitation strategies and techniques learned through the ED5151 course, and to gain practical experience implementing an online workshop in a school district or educational organization. Participants will select a specific online workshop aligned to the professional development needs within their local district or organization, and facilitate this workshop for colleagues, under the supervision of program faculty. Participants will participate in a faculty-led semester-long online forum with other student facilitators, to share experiences and reflect on key issues in online professional development.

Course Requirements

Participants are required to facilitate an online workshop and participate in the ETLO Forum throughout the facilitation, posting at least eight times during that period. Participants are also required to submit a final product to the course instructor via email, with the following three items:

1. Required elements from facilitating the online workshop,
2. Annotated postings from the Forum, and
3. A final reflective paper.

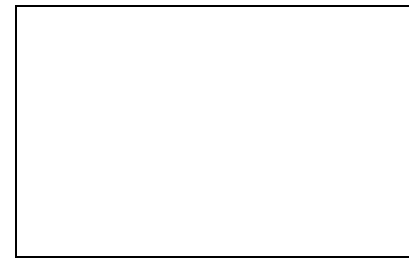
ED5152: COURSE REQUIREMENTS

ED5152 is a practicum course that functions as a graduate-level seminar, using the ETLO Forum for communication among participants and faculty. Participants are required to facilitate an online workshop and participate in the Forum throughout the facilitation, posting at least eight times during that period. Participants are also required to submit a final product to the course instructor via email, with the following three items described below: 1) required elements from facilitating the online workshop, 2) annotated postings from the Forum, and 3) a final reflective paper.

<p>Final Reflection Paper Participants will complete a 3–6 page final reflection paper, assessing the strengths and weaknesses of their facilitation of the workshop. The reflection paper should include the following:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. An evaluation of workshop participants' learning outcomes 2. Reflective response to the following questions: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a) What were the strengths and weaknesses of your facilitation, and how did they affect participant learning in the workshop? b) What were your biggest challenges and successes as an online instructor? What strategies will you take away from this experience for use in future online instruction/facilitation? 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Demonstrate an understanding of the key challenges of and important strategies for learning and teaching online 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 3–6 page reflection paper, addressing learning outcomes of participants and facilitation experience of facilitator • Should include responses to the reflective questions at left under Assignment
